Thank you for writing to us about the above Penalty Charge Notice (PCN).

We have carefully considered what you say but we have decided not to cancel your Penalty Charge Notice (PCN).

We sent you a PCN because our CCTV camera evidence shows your vehicle entering a pedestrian zone when it was not allowed to. There is a white, rectangular sign which says 'Pedestrian zone' and shows the rules.

Please note that there are signs on both side of the lane and are positioned to face on-coming vehicles from both end of Atlantic Road. The signs informs motorists that **Vehicles/Motorcycles** are not permitted to enter during the operational hours which are **Mon – Tues, Thurs – Sat 8 am – 6 pm Wednesday 8 am – 2 pm (Except for loading between 8 am – 9 am and 5 pm – 6pm)**.

It is the responsibility of the driver of the vehicle to ensure that all traffic signs are observed and adhered to at all time.
